## Category 1A: Academic Fees – Program Fees (Fees charged as a single rate)

If you cancel your registration for the session, Program fees are reversed in accordance with this schedule, using the registration cancellation date recorded on ROSI. Cancellation of registration only occurs when all courses are cancelled. If any courses with a final standing remain on the record for the academic session—a final mark, CR/NCR, LWD, or WDR—a student will not be eligible to cancel the registration for that session, and thus will not be eligible to have the program fee charges reduced.
