- 3) CTEP students who drop their course load to fewer than 1.5 credits in a semester during the 50% refund period will have 50% of the full-time Program fee reversed, and will also be charged 50% of the CTEP Per-Course fees charged according to the students' credit weight for the semester. No incidental fee adjustment is made.
- 4) There may be additional ancillary fees levied for enrolment in specific courses or for individual circumstances. Co-op, Teaching and Centennial Joint programs have additional program fees (see Table 4A or 4B or 4C). Check your online invoice.
