Program Fee	A flat fee for studies in the Fall-Winter Session. All students are initially charged a Program Fee, regardless of course load.		
Course Fees	Fees assessed on a course by course basis. When a course is added, the course fee is charged immediately, regardless of when the course begins. When a course is canceled, the course fee is reversed in accordance with the relevant refund schedule.

Definitions

Course Load Count	 For Program Fee assessment purposes, course load is determined using the following formula: F+Y courses (as of September 23, 2020) + S courses (as of January 17, 2021) = course load count. Course Load Count does not apply to Rotman Commerce Specialists or CTEP students.
Minimum Charge	A minimum charge (\$294 + a \$55 System Access Fee) will be charged to students who cancel their registration in this session in a degree or non-degree program on or after the published date for the first day of classes for the Fall-Winter Session.
Incidental Fees	Mandatory fees for university and student society services.
Ancillary Fees	Mandatory fees charged for specific courses or programs (e.g. laboratory fees.)
System Access Fee	Mandatory fee for access to ACORN.
